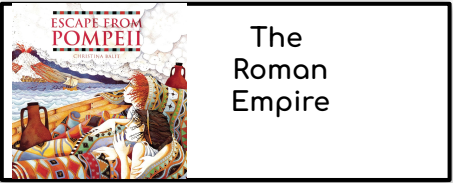
**Computing: Systems and Networks:**  
 This half term we will be learning how to safely send and receive emails using our own email address as well as our usual e-safety session.

**Modern Foreign Languages: French:**  
 In French this half term we will be learning to count up to 30, the months of the year and how to give information about our birthdays.

**Reading:** The focus this term during whole class guided reading session is the retrieval of information from texts. This a vital skill which involves skimming and scanning the text for specific information as well as finding specific evidence to answer questions about character's thoughts and feelings.



**PSHE:**  
 This half term in PSHE we will be discussing our Dreams and Goals for the future. We will learning how to break down our ideas into achievable goals.

**RE:** This half term in RE we will be focusing on what Christians learn from the Creation story. We will be discussing and making links about what is said in Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God and Creation.

**Christian Ethos:**  
 This term's Christian value is 'Hope'. We will be considering what this means to us as a Christian school and how shared hope as a community encourages spirituality as part of wider British society.

**Mathematics:**
