Writing: This half term we will be using the story, 'The Wreck of the Zanzibar' by Michael Morpurgo for our writing focus. It is a beautiful story set in the Isles of Scilly. We will be writing character and setting descriptions, diary entries and then finishing off with some poetry based on our senses. .

Computing: Systems and Networks
 We will be learning how devices communicate. From identifying components, learn how information is shared and by exploring examples of real-world networks, plus termly online safety lessons.

Design Technology: This half term we will be learning how to use digital coding using an app. We will be using the app to create a programme that will enable a light to turn on and off.

PE: This half term we will be taking part in Forest School. The children will be spending Wednesday afternoon outside whatever the weather! Our other PE session will be on a Tuesday, focusing on practising the fundamental skills.

Modern Foreign Languages: French
This is Me: This half term we will learn how to exchange greetings and share personal information such as names and how we are feeling.

Reading: The focus this term during whole class guided reading sessions is the retrieval of information from texts. This a vital skill which involves skimming and scanning the text for specific information as well as finding specific evidence to answer questions about character's thoughts and feelings.



PSHE: This half terms puzzle piece is 'Being Me in My World' and it focuses on being comfortable with ourselves and accepting others for who they are. We will also discuss bullying and how to access support.

RE:
 This half term we will be learning about what it is like to be Hindu in contemporary Britain. We will be focusing on what it means to be a Hindu, how they worship and the important festivals that they celebrate.

Christian Ethos: This term's Christian value is Wisdom. As a school we will be thinking about what this means in a secular and Christian context and how we can use it in everyday life. Rev Chris will be guiding us through his fortnightly collective worships.

Mathematics:
 Our learning this term is going to be focused on Number and Place Value. We will be taking part in different challenges that will help to embed their learning. We will continue to practise our times tables daily.

Geography: This half term we will be learning about the different areas of the United Kingdom. We will be learning about counties, cities and the differences between urban and rural areas.

Music:
 This term's music is focused around R&B style music. We will be learning to sing, play and compose on a theme to perform a children's R&B song called Let Your Spirit Fly.

Science: Living things and their habitats.
 We will be learning about how we can sort and classify living things using classification keys to identify them. We will find out about habitats and how they can change through natural and human induced change.
